Statement of Representation by Independent Registered Municipal Advisor

Everett Public Facilities District, Snohomish County, Washington (the "District") publicly posts this written disclosure to assist market participants in their compliance with an exemption from the Municipal Advisor Rule promulgated by the Securities and Exchange Commission. By publicly posting this written disclosure, the District intends that market participants receive and use it for purposes of the independent registered municipal advisor exemption.

The District has retained Northwest Municipal Advisors (the "Municipal Advisor") to provide advice to the District with respect to the issuance of its municipal securities. The Municipal Advisor has represented to the District that the Municipal Advisor is an independent registered municipal advisor within the meaning of the Municipal Advisor Rule.


